In the interest of both parties to establish stable and balanced relations based on cooperation, understanding and coordination between them, the parties to this contract have been connected with the signing of this Agreement Relying on the principle of dialogue, constructive and purpose, which is the best method and a successful way to settle all disputes and disputes between the parties of production. The union working for education workers is valued for the general administration of the old schools in order to provide the conditions and conditions of work appropriate, which was recently approved a financial increase of 30 dinars per month for all workers in schools Which has had a significant impact on creating a safe and comfortable environment for work in addition to other privileges offered by age schools for workers. And after meetings and consultations dominated by the atmosphere of

understanding and the spirit of friendliness and the overriding public interest has been agreed on the following:

- The two sides agreed to form a joint committee between the two parties, depending on the principle of dialogue and cooperation to resolve any differences that may arise between the two parties in the future.
- The monthly subscription fee in the General Union of Education Workers shall be complied with by the accounting of the schools so that they shall be deducted from the salaries of the employees affiliated with the union and provided to the union account.
- Taking into account the provisions of the provisions of the Jordanian Labor Law in force regarding the rights and duties of each teacher working in these schools, while preserving the privileges and acquired rights obtained for the employees before signing this agreement.
