### **Minutes of Session**

**A working session was held on Friday, 2 May 2014 between the General Union of Education Workers and a delegation from the Ministry of Education, In the presence of Mr. Mustafa Al-Alawi, Chief of the Cabinet of the Minister of Education and Hafiz Hafiz, Assistant Secretary-General in Charge of the Public Service of the General Union of Tunisian Labor, To follow up the implementation of the terms of the agreement between the parties:**

**1. Liability Grant:** The order was approved by the Council of Ministers on 2 May 2014.

**2. Code of Plans:** It was signed by the Prime Minister and the Minister of Education and is approved for the rearrangement of workers.

**3. Reclassification of workers:** After studying the files for the reclassification of workers in charge of the competent accreditation of the adoption of the new code of plans, the Ministry began to settle all positions.

**4. Workers assigned to administrative work:**

(A) The effect of re-classification of the workers assigned to an administrative work, which shall be integrated into the administrative hierarchy in accordance with the current arrangements.

(B) For workers assigned to administrative work by the Central Administration or regional delegates who have a seniority, not less than five (5) years and the Ministry has begun to integrate them into the administrative corps.

**5. University scholarships:** The Ministry is committed to the provisions of the agreement 20 / June, The workers of the education system have 430 university grants for 2013-2014 in coordination with the Ministry of Higher Education.

**6 . Return the expelled:** The Ministry approved the request of the union to study the files of the expelled in order to return those who meet the conditions agreed by the parties.

**7. Sector Support:** The Ministry works to support the sector and compensate retirees and departures with the fair distribution of centers to institutions and institutions.

**The parties also agreed to continue negotiating the rest of the demands in the sector regulations, Such as: exceptional promotions, review of work uniforms, distribution of university grants and new grants (social work grants) and the Basic Law for the workers of education and a reduction in the salaries of workers in the Office of Housing Ministry of Education.**

**As a result, the General Union of Education Workers decided to cancel the strike scheduled for 6/7/8 May 2014.**
